TUNISIA'S CONSTITUTIONAL REFERENDUM

Tunisians will go to the polls on July 25th to vote on an amended constitution which increases the powers of the President, more than ten years after the Arab Spring revolt in 2011. On this occasion, France 24's four channels in French, in English, in Arabic and in Spanish will provide special coverage throughout the day.
